When you think of people who overcame chaos in their lives, who comes to mind? Why? What were some characteristics or values that helped them deal with chaos?

Do you consider yourself a planner? How do you react when things don't go according to plan?

Joseph needs to deal with many kinds of chaos during his life. Which of the trials that he faced would you have most struggled with? [Broken Dreams, Betrayal by family, slavery, false accusations, wrongful imprisonment, etc] Why? (Review Genesis 37:5-8, 37:19-27, 39:6-20 if needed)

Often, when we face Chaos, we are tempted to think that other people are the cause of our chaos. How does Joseph treat his brothers when they come to Joseph for help? Why didn't Joseph get revenge? (Genesis 50:20)

When our plans change, how can we learn to look for God's hand at work? Are you able to share an example God using chaos to bring about good in your life?

Consider James 4:13-15. How is this seemingly harsh statement actually helpful with perspective? How should God's will influence and interact with our plans? Why is it sometimes easy to forget God when we make our plans? How did Jesus show that he was willing to follow the Father's plan?

How can we help our friends, communities, and neighbors deal with their chaos?
